

Paraprofessionals provide support to students with special needs, and act as extra staff in classrooms for students with emotional and behavioral difficulties and performing a variety of important duties that require skill in preventing and managing behavior."

In this course, participants will read the book <u>Behavior Support Strategies for Education</u> <u>Paraprofessionals by Will Henson, Psyd</u>., as well as supplemental articles provided by the instructor. Each week the instructor will facilitate a discussion on the readings and allow participants to share their experiences, challenges, and successes with each other. Written reflections will also be assigned.

The instructor will share the reading schedule and provide review the procedure for asynchronous work. The book will be provided for you to borrow. You will need to have access to a device for Google Meets/ Zoom and to receive and submit assignments.

Strategies for implementing rules and procedures, building relationships with students, communicating high expectations, and using engagement techniques will be the focus of this course. Teachers will learn the most up to date techniques to teach in a way that draws from the past, is rooted in the present while keeping an eye on the future. Each teacher must discover what works best for him or her and make it their own.
